



## **ITWG-23, 23rd Annual Meeting**

**4 – 8 June 2018**

The Nuclear Forensics International Technical Working Group (ITWG) unites practitioners in nuclear forensics, scientists, law enforcement agencies and regulatory bodies of various nations as well as international authorities who share the task of managing incidents of nuclear and radioactive materials out of regulatory control. The objective of the ITWG is to advance the scientific discipline of nuclear forensics and to provide a common approach and effective technical solutions to competent national or international authorities. Attendance to the ITWG is open to experts from nations with designated nuclear forensics or from nations who are building up such capabilities.

Switzerland represented by Spiez Laboratory has been a member of ITWG for 10 years and will host this year's Annual Meeting.

The Annual Meeting will start Tuesday, 5 June 2018 in the morning and end of Thursday, 7 June 2018 in the afternoon. The meeting will take place in the Federal Training Centre (FTCS) located in Schwarzenburg. An optional morning tour of Spiez Laboratory will be offered on Friday, 8 June 2018.

Participation in the ITWG-23 is only possible by invitation. Approx. 130 experts from over 30 countries and 5 international organisations are expected to attend.
